THIS IS NOT A LEASE OF ANY SPACE BUT MERELY A REVOCABLE LICENSE OR PERMIT ON THE TERMS OUTLINED. The undersigned, as part of this application for stabling any or all of the horses listed here at Sunland Park Racetrack & Casino for the upcoming season, and in consideration of the rights and privileges that may be granted pursuant to this application, does hereby agree to the following terms and conditions. **(1)** SGMNM, LLC reserves the right to cancel this application for stable space in whole or in part, or to refuse the acceptance of any entry in any race at any time for any reason or cause and without notice to the undersigned. **(2)** The undersigned agrees: (a) To abide by all rules, regulations and policies of SGMNM, LLC pertaining to stabling, occupancy and the use of premises at Sunland Park, including rules and regulations contained in the Sunland Park Condition Book and Horsemen's Guide. (b) To vacate the stalls and to move any and all horses, equipment, property and personnel off the premises at Sunland Park within three (3) days after requested to do so, unless urgent circumstances (as defined by Sunland Park) require a shorter time period. (c) SGMNM, LLC its owners, members, manager, agents or employees, will not be liable or responsible for any injury or loss suffered in any manner by or to undersigned or other injury or loss by or to the horses, equipment, or other property of the undersigned or of personnel, agents, employees, contractors, or invitees of the undersigned while on or off the premises or while being transported in any manner on or off the premises ,or related to or resulting from practicing or taking part in physical training, a sport or athletic activity or contest, including the exercising, racing and/or caring for horses. (d) **That the undersigned hereby releases SGMNM, LLC its owners, members, manager, agents and employees from and against all claims of such injury or loss by or on behalf of the undersigned, their personnel, agents, employees, contractors and invitees.** (e) **To save and hold harmless, and indemnify, SGMNM, LLC its owners, members, manager, agents and employees, from all losses, costs, damages, liabilities, expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees and expenses of any nature), of any kind due to or arising out of or from the stabling and/or action of horses or other animals of or in the charge of or through the undersigned at Sunland Park, or from the use or occupancy of the stalls or premises (including but not limited to training and racing), or by reason of any acts, omissions or other fault of the undersigned or by any of its employees, agents, contractors, veterinarians and invitees.** (3) No stabling will be permitted except in accordance with this application. No entry in any race will be received except upon conditions that all disputes, claims, and obligations arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions or races otherwise shall be decided by the New Mexico Racing Commission, the Stewards of the meeting or SGMNM, LLC as the case may be and such decisions upon all points shall be final.

Past Performance Lines from Daily Racing Form MUST accompany this application on ANY horse. Failure to do so will result in application being returned. Trainers arriving after January 8, 2027 must ALSO apply for stalls.

(4) In all stakes races, acceptance must be made through the entry box by a specified time before the race. **(5)** Any stalls not filled by the assigned trainers will revert to Sunland Park. **See back of application.** **(6)** All stabling and all entries in all races are received and accepted subject to all conditions, rules and regulations of the New Mexico Racing Commission and of SGMNM, LLC. **(7)** No payment of any nomination or eligibility fee for any stakes race shall entitle a horse to stabling at Sunland Park. **(8)** SGMNM, LLC its agents, employees, or designees, may desire to televise directly or by photographic transcription all or some of the races at Sunland Park, and reserves all rights to reproduce, transcribe or transmit such races directly by television or otherwise without compensation to anyone. Entries will be accepted only on the condition that if requested by SGMNM, LLC the owner, the jockey, trainer, the groom and all other employees of the owner or trainer coming within view of the television cameras will sign and deliver to SGMNM, LLC consents or releases, permitting such television and the exhibition thereof in any manner at any time without compensation to anyone. **(9)** The undersigned represents that he/she and all for whom he/she is acting, have read or familiarize themselves with the Rules of Racing and the regulations of the New Mexico Racing Commission, Horsemen's Guide, the Sunland Park Condition Book and this application, and agrees to be bound thereby, and further agrees that all animals shall be subject to such rules and regulations and the acts and decisions of the race officials and Sunland Park management. **(10)** The undersigned represents that he/she has the right to make the above representations with respect to every owner of every horse listed herein and any person on the premises through undersigned, and that such owner and persons will be bound hereby. **(11)** All horses whose stall applications are accepted are subject to veterinarian's examination. Any horse not in condition to run during the meeting will not be stabled at Sunland Park. **(12)** No additions or improvements to the stalls or premises shall be made without prior written approval of SGMNM, LLC. **(13)** The undersigned agrees to maintain the stalls and premises in a clean, orderly and safe condition at all times, (including but not limited to fire and life safety standards) and to place manure and debris in the garbage containers on a daily basis. The undersigned shall be responsible and liable for any and all waste (including without limitation veterinary waste) disposed of or left for disposal in connection with the undersigned's horses and indemnifies and holds harmless SGMNM, LLC from and against any liability in connection therewith including attorney's fees. **(14)** SGMNM, LLC may assign its rights and obligations hereunder without any prior consent of the other party hereto and in the event of such an assignment, SGMNM, LLC shall be released from all obligations hereunder that arose after such an assignment.

Any horse under the care of a trainer whose license is suspended after November 13, 2026 must re-apply for stall space within five (5) business days of the ruling of suspension. Those horse owners must also sign the re-application.

Failure to vacate by the last date as set by Sunland Park will result in a stall rental fee and could result in failure to get stall space in the future. SPRC reserves the right to do additional testing on all horses at any time while they are on the grounds of SPRC, as well as any other rights said association has as a private property owner.

SUNLAND PARK SCREENING RULES FOR THE 2026-2027 RACING SEASON

1. Only two year olds (foals of 2025) that are registered New Mexico Bred or nominated to a race at Sunland Park will be allowed to occupy stall space.
2. No maiden quarter horses older than five years old. No maiden thoroughbreds older than seven years old.
3. Any horse placed on the poor performance list twice during the meet will be ineligible to start and must be removed from the grounds.
4. Any horse (winners) that has started for a claiming price of less than \$3,000 for eligibility: must have finished first, second, third, or fourth for \$3,000 claiming or higher since last starting for less than \$3,000 claiming. Maidens that have started for a maiden claiming price of less than \$5,000 for eligibility: must finish first, second, third or fourth for maiden \$5,000 claiming or higher since last starting for less than maiden \$5,000 claiming.
5. Minimum claiming price is \$5,000.

POLICIES FOR THE 2026-2027 RACING SEASON STALL APPROVALS

1. The Application does not become a binding Stall License Agreement ("License") until signed on behalf of Sunland Park Racetrack & Casino by its Racing Secretary or other authorized agent, and shall remain revocable at the sole discretion of Sunland Park Racetrack & Casino at all times.
2. Falsification of any information in this stall application may result in denial, cancellation or revocation of this application and any license resulting here from.
3. If the trainer has not bedded assigned stalls or made arrangements with management to show intent of occupying stalls, the stalls will be reassigned after the first entry day.
4. Access to the Sunland Park backstretch shall be restricted until all written consents are received permitting the simulcast export of the 2026-27 Sunland Park race meet under the Interstate Horse Racing Act of 1978.
5. Trainers will be fully responsible for tack rooms assigned or used.
6. In slips and out slips will be required on all horses.
7. Stalls will be allocated based on balance of application and quality of past performances supplied with application. Prior participation and previous rulings of applicant will also be considered, along with any other information deemed relevant by the Stall Committee.
8. All applications will include past performances of all horses and current license of trainer applying.
9. New Mexico Breds on each application shall have preference over horses of comparable quality.
10. Negative test for Piroplasmosis is required for ALL Quarter Horses within twelve (12) months prior to entry into the grounds of Sunland Park. A copy of the negative Equine Piroplasmosis test must be attached to the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued by an accredited veterinarian. All horses entering the Sunland Park stable area (including stable ponies) must present the following: 1) A valid negative Coggins test certificate issued within the past 30 days of entry to the Sunland Park Grounds. 2) A health certificate issued at the point of origin within the past thirty (30) days if coming directly from a licensed racetrack in the state of New Mexico, otherwise an Original (Owner's Copy) of a Health certificate issued at the point of origin within the previous five (5) days of arrival. 3) Verification of Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis vaccinations within the past six (6) months and verification of Eastern and Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Rabies, and West Nile Vaccinations within the last twelve (12) months. **No Exceptions.** Requirements for entry to stable area are subject to change at any time.
